Memorial Day

First instituted to remember soldiers who died in the Civil War, it was originally called "Decoration Day" for the tradition of decorating soldiers' graves. After World War I, the observance broadened to include the fallen of all American wars. In 1882 the name 'Memorial Day' began being used, becoming the 'official name' under federal law in 1967.
